- She speaks wisely and kindly
- Her children and husband praise her
- Everyone speaks highly of her

History: Virtue defined: 1. Morally good; acting in conformity to moral law; practicing the moral duties and abstaining from vice. 2. Being in conformity to moral or divine law. 3. Chaste; *applied to women*.

We're told that God gave Solomon an exceeding amount of wisdom in 1 Kings 4:29 "And God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that is on the sea shore".

Solomon also had seven hundred wives, princesses, & three hundred concubines according to 1 Kings 11:3, so he probably knew a lot about all kinds of women, good and bad.

Memory Verse: Proverbs 31:10 "Who can find a virtuous woman? For her price is far above rubies".
